Stop #2 – The Arrival

- 3) How were first and second class passengers treated differently than third class passengers when they reached Ellis Island?
- 4) What was it like for Lawrence Meinwald coming into New York Harbor?

Stop #3 – The Baggage Room

- 5) What was given to all immigrants who disembarked the steamers?
- 6) Describe Manny Steen's experience entering Ellis Island.

Stop #4 – The Stairs

- 7) How many people did the officials at Ellis expect per year? How many came in 1907?
- 8) What did officials look for as people climbed the stair to the Registry Room?

Stop #5 – The Registry Room

- 9) Explain how the Great Hall could have been so confusing and scary for a new immigrant.
- 10) Why did the agent not believe that Lucy Attarian was her parents' child? Why did her parents not produce proof?

Stop #6 – The Medical Exam

- 11) Approximately how many were denied entry into America? What was the United States trying to prevent by denying some immigrants entrance?
- 12) Identify the following medical shorthand:
Suspected mental defect, definite signs of mental disease, back, conjunctivitis, trachoma, eyes, face, feet, goiter, heart, hernia, lameness, neck, physical and lungs, pregnancy, scalp, senility
